Tuition

- Young 3's class: \$100. per month
(Jan. - May)
- 3 year old class: \$105. per month
(Sept. - May)
- 4 year old class: \$130. per month
(Sept. - May)

Requirements

Age: Children must be age 3 or 4 by September 1st of the current calendar year. This policy concurs with the Hillsboro Elementary District and Forest Hills Lutheran School. To Enroll in our Young 3's class children must be 3 by December 31st.

Potty Trained: Children must be completely potty trained before the beginning of the school year. There is a child friendly bathroom within our classrooms.

Immunizations: Children must be current on all required immunizations. An approved immunization record from either a doctor or a health clinic must be submitted by the first day of class.

Registration Process

Registration is accomplished by submitting a completed registration form to the preschool or church office along with a non-refundable registration fee of \$50 (\$25 for Young 3's class).

Registration opens to the public on Monday, February 1st and is on a "first come, first serve" basis. When classes are filled, we will maintain a waiting list.

Snack time

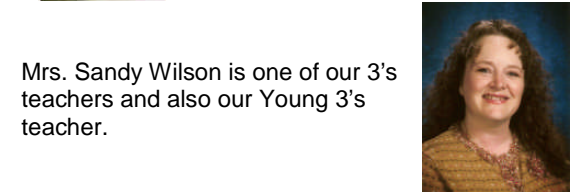
Eating and giving thanks. Developing an understanding of health and food groups.
